Welcome to the Margaret River Recreation Centre Crèche Service.

Please read this important information carefully to help us to provide a safe and happy environment for all children in our Crèche Service.

Registration/Cost

When entering the Crèche for each session, children must be signed-in and signed-out by the same Parent/Carer. Crèche fees are payable at the front counter prior to entering the crèche. Each session is 75 minutes (max 2 sessions). If you go over this time you must pay for 2 sessions.

Access to the child whilst in our Crèche

You are the only person able to collect your child or have access to your child whilst they are in the Crèche unless we receive separate written notification advising us of the person's details. Please also note that it is a requirement that the nominated person to collect your child must show photo identification to the Crèche Staff.

Infectious diseases/conditions

Children with infectious conditions cannot be accepted into the Crèche. Such conditions include chicken pox, mumps, measles, conjunctivitis, gastroenteritis, ring worm/tinea, diarrhoea, vomiting, and head lice. It is at the discretion of the Crèche Staff to determine if your child is unwell and not able to attend the facility.

No medication will be administered by Crèche Staff. This excludes any cases of accident or emergency situations where the Crèche Staff will administer first aid to a child. All Crèche Staff will follow the 'Recommended Minimum Exclusion Periods for Infectious Conditions for Schools, Pre-schools and Child Care Centres December 2005' as issued by the National Health and Medical Research Council.

Immunisation

All children who attend the Crèche must be immunised. Immunisation records are to be presented at the time of enrolment.

Snacks

If you would like your child to have a snack whilst in the Crèche, please bring fruit or sandwiches. Our Crèche is an ALLERGY AWARENESS ZONE and endorse a NO NUTS ALLOWED policy and we are not able to allow any food items that contain traces of nuts. Please note that staff rarely have time to spoon feed babies and toddlers. Please prepare fruit in the way your child prefers (e.g. peeled, sliced, etc.). Children are only given food which their Parent/Carer has provided.

Changeover congestion

Changeovers are very hectic times in the Crèche. Please bring your child/ren to the Crèche five to ten minutes before the start of your activity. Also, your promptness in collection is appreciated.

Children's belongings

All possessions (e.g. bottles, dummies, bags, special toys, etc.) must be clearly named to avoid any items being lost. Please bring any necessary toilet provisions (e.g. nappies, change of clothing) and if your child is toilet trained please assist our Crèche Staff by taking your child/ren to the toilet prior to admittance to the Crèche.

Pusher/Stroller

Please bring a pusher/stroller if possible for your small child as it is comforting for them.

Age of children

We accept children from 8 weeks through to 12 years.
